GRACE Patient Education Ambassador Program Overview

This nomination-only program is open to all oncology fellows and finishing fellows. GRACE's designated committee will review the nominees and select up to 4 participants for the honor of participating in the 2020 program. Nominees for this program will include those still in fellowship and embarking on their post-fellowship junior faculty or practice opportunities; however, it is required that they are still a fellow at the time of the application deadline.

Benefits of Participation

Selected fellows will work closely with national and international leaders in various fields of oncology to develop new educational content for patients across a range of platforms that will help them become established emerging contributors in their fields of interest. They will receive training on digitally distributed content and social media, and their work will be highlighted and shared by the internationally recognized non-profit GRACE organization, along with its network of established leaders in the oncology community and board members with an array of interests and connections. Participants will receive a minimal stipend which will include paid training in doctor-to-patient/family and broader communication in the field.
